

Wildlife Habitat Improvement Local District Fund Criteria Form

The Wildlife Habitat Improvement Local District (WHILD) Fund grant criteria form is used in determining the use of funds available on an annual basis. The Grant Committee shall be appointed by the Foundation and shall consist of one appointee with expertise in habitat improvement, wildlife management, wildlife habitat management or wildlife biology from each of the following entities: Colorado Parks and Wildlife, United States Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management, Colorado State Forest, and two members from the general public chosen by the Board of Trustees of the Yampa Valley Community Foundation and who each serves a three-year term at the pleasure of the Yampa Valley Community Foundation members.
