We are staffing an aid station for Run Rabbit Run to raise money for the endowment September 8-9

Even if you are well prepared, running 100 miles over mountainous terrain is a very difficult task. It becomes even more difficult when the task must be completed non-stop, day and night, in less than 35 hours.

On September 8 and 9, a group of brave runners will complete the Run Rabbit Run 100 mile trail race in Steamboat Springs, CO. And members of the South Routt Education Endowment Fund (SREEF), a tax deductible 501c3 charitable organization, will help every runner by staffing the Cow Creek Aid Station.



The race course begins at the base of Mt. Werner and will cover over 20,000 vertical feet of elevation gains and losses. The trails and hills to be conquered will span much of the Yampa Valley and include some of our most scenic locations. When they get to the Cow Creek Aid Station (about 40 miles into the race), a group of SREEF Volunteers will hand out food, refill water bottles, offer medical aid, and encourage the runners.

SREEF has a long history with Run Rabbit Run race. A team of South Routt teachers, parents, and community members completed the 100 mile course at its inaugural event in 2012. During that event, the SREEF charity raised over \$5,000. During subsequent years, SREEF collected additional donations and we want to continue our fundraising efforts this September.
